MORE THAN \$30,000 AWARDED TO GREATER WICHITA FIRE DEPARTMENTS

Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation is celebrating \$30,256 worth of lifesaving equipment grants awarded to Andover Fire Rescue, Sumner County Fire District #8 and Wellington Fire & EMS.

DONATION DESCRIPTION

Andover Fire Rescue received portable radios and a thermal imaging camera worth \$19,156. The awarded radios will improve communication between the department and county dispatchers, while the thermal imaging camera will be used to detect body heat and hot spots in burning buildings, allowing firefighters to quickly reach victims and provide life-saving assistance.

Sumner County Fire District #8 received a new foam system with nozzles worth \$4,125. The awarded equipment will replace the existing 20-year-old system. Using foam will assist the all-volunteer department in putting out fires quicker and more efficiently.

Wellington Fire & EMS received extrication equipment worth \$6,975. The awarded equipment will improve the department's rescue capabilities for victims in motor vehicle accidents.
