No. 7 Township Fire & Rescue received eight sets of turnout gear worth \$20,257. The awarded equipment, which includes turnout coats, trousers, helmets, helmet shields and boots, will replace old, damaged gear, allowing firefighters to provide safe and efficient services to their community.

New Bern Police Department received a police service dog (K9) worth \$16,582. The awarded K9 and equipment will be used by the police department to perform suspect and area searches without compromising officer safety.
